

Psychology Participant Pool Sign Up: How To

CREATE ACCOUNT

• Go to psucc.sona~systems.com

Type this in/click hyperlink. Do NOT search & click.

- Go to Request Account
- Follow prompts in **Account Information**
- Select your courses you would like to receive credits for (you can make changes later, too)
- Click Request Account

ACCOUNT LOG IN

- Check your PSU E-mail for your log in and password
- Go back to psucc.sona~systems.com
- Log in using new account information
- Change **password**
- Go to View Available Studies-Here you can choose which studies you would like to participate in based on their description
- Click Timeslots Available
- Then click **View Time Slots for this Study**
- Find a Timeslot that works for you then click sign up
- You're done!



1. Do I need to create an account in order to participate in required or extra credit studies?

~Yes

2. Can I use my personal email?

-Not to sign up/in. BUT you can add your personal email for message forwarding.

3. Will I receive a reminder?

~Yes. You will receive a reminder email one day before your scheduled time.

4. What If I suddenly can't make my appointment?

-Go back to the website above to cancel any appointments 24 hours prior to your appointment time. You can also email the researcher (see your timeslot).

5. What if I skip my appointment without officially canceling?

-It is up to the researcher if you can reschedule your appointment. At the end of the term it is more difficult to reschedule.

6. Do I have to decide where my credits will go when I sign up?

-No. You may reassign your credits earned any time before the pool closes (it closes on the last day of classes at 5:00pm).

7. Are there any online studies?

-Usually. You can partake in the online studies as soon as you sign up.

8. When is the deadline to sign up?

-You can sign up at any point before the end of the semester.

9. Will my instructors see which studies I participated in?

-No. Your instructor will only see how many experiment credits you received. All participation is confidential.

10. I didn't receive my credits <u>and</u> it has been 48 hours since I completed the study.
